

Running a Plarn Bag Project

Anyone can run a plarn making and bag crocheting project at their school or other community. It just takes a few steps:

- Holding a Plastic Bag Drive
 - In order to make a lot of plarn, you need a *lot* of plastic bags. Holding a plastic bag drive in your community is a great way to collect them!
 - Putting up posters around your school, distributing flyers, or sending an email out to friends and neighbors are all good ways to collect plenty of plastic bags. Here's the poster I put up in my school:
